I understand that:

- **Only one overlapping upper division course** will be allowed between the student's declared major and the Aerospace Engineering (AE) minor. **Mechanical Engineering (ME) students ONLY** can overlap the following 3 prerequisite courses with their major: ME C85, ME 106 and ME 132. Note however, the remaining 3 upper division courses: **ME 127, ME 136 and ME 163 or AE C162/ME C162 cannot overlap or double count as ME Technical Electives for the ME major.**
- A minimum grade-point average (GPA) of 2.0 is required for the upper division courses used to fulfill the minor requirement, as well as 2.0 overall Berkeley GPA.
- All required minor courses must be completed with passing letter grades by the last day of finals of expected graduation term.
- Completion of the minor cannot delay a student's graduation. Students should notify Minor Program Adviser if they no longer intend to complete the minor, or if their expected semester of graduation changes.
